Proposals should include admission costs and any equipment necessary to conduct the activities. Activities shall include, but not limited to:

The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to receive Proposals on **Tuesday, April 27, 2010 at 11:00 a.m. in the City Council Chambers**, Second Floor, City Hall, Sixth and Market Streets, Camden, New Jersey, at which time and place proposal will be opened and read publicly.

Proposals should include admission costs or service costs and any equipment necessary to conduct the activities. **Guidelines** for the Proposal may be obtained in the office of the Purchasing Agent, Room 213, City Hall, Sixth and Market Streets, Camden, New Jersey during normal working hours.

Sealed proposals intended for the Purchasing Agent prior to the designated time of public opening shall be delivered to the Office of the Business Administrator, City Hall, Room 409, Camden, New Jersey 08101.

If awarded a contract, the contractor will be required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c27 (law against discrimination in public contract).

This proposal is being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with the N.J.S.A. 19:44a-20.5 et seq.

Proposals will not be accepted after the time specified for submission. Proposals received after the hour appointed will be deemed invalid and returned unopened to sender.
