PRESS ALERT

Press Conference to Announce the “Camden Citizen’s Anonymous Tip Line” is scheduled for Monday, March 31, 2008 at 12:30 p.m.

Camden- The Camden City Police Department, in partnership with the New Jersey State Police, the Camden County Prosecutors Office, the Citizens Crime Commission of Delaware Valley and Operation CeaseFire NJ will hold a press conference on the ground floor of the Camden City Police Department Administration Building located at 800 Federal Street Camden, NJ 08103 on March 31, 2008 at 12:30 pm to announce the new crime fighting initiative “Camden Citizen’s Anonymous Tip Line”.

In an effort to reduce violent crime in the City of Camden, this collaborative effort was formed for the purpose of encouraging citizens to provide information about illegal gun possession and gun related criminal activity in the City of Camden to law enforcement officials.

The sum of \$30,000 has been raised to fund this public safety initiative. Using this fund, monetary rewards will be paid to individuals who provide information leading to the arrest and / or conviction of persons who are involved in firearm related crime in the City of Camden.

Also, at this Press Conference, the Camden City Police Department will be providing an update on the number of firearms seized as a result of the on-going law enforcement crime suppression efforts during the past three months. A sampling of the firearms recovered so far this year will be on display.

In an effort to reduce violent crime in the city, the Camden City Police Department will continue to aggressively target illegally possessed firearms in an effort to enhance the security and well being of the residents of Camden.
