CITY OF CAMDEN NOW OFFERING ONLINE TAX PAYMENTS

CAMDEN – Mayor Dana L. Redd today announced that property owners will now be able to make property tax payments online. Beginning July 28, 2014, the Tax Collector will be accepting online payments at <http://www.ci.camden.nj.us/revenue-collections>

“As Mayor, I continue to evaluate our municipal operations to see how we can efficiently deliver City services to our residents and business owners,” Mayor Redd said. “Many of our municipal functions have been overhauled as antiquated systems and inefficient practices have been modernized and streamlined. This service will only be available to those who are current on their taxes. All outstanding liens, water, sewer and CCMUA bills cannot be paid via the City website. Those individuals who do not wish to make payments online are still able to make payments at the Tax Collector’s Office from Monday thru Friday, between the hours of 8:30am - 4:30pm.
