**CITY TRASH COLLECTION SCHEDULE TO RESUME ONCE A WEEK PICK-UP
STARTING OCTOBER 1**

CAMDEN – City officials today announced that the City trash collection schedule will resume to once a week pick-up starting October 1, 2014. Recycling collection remains the same.

Mayor Dana L. Redd urges residents and businesses to continue separating recyclables from regular garbage. Recycling not only benefits our environment, but it is also cost efficient for the City because it reduces the amount of tonnage which lowers the fees the City pays to the landfill and incinerator facilities. Also, the City can receive refunds for certain types of recyclables, depending on the market for paper, aluminum, etc.

Residents or businesses who have questions, would like to obtain more information about their trash collection schedule, need to know which trash collection district they live in, or would like to pick-up a recycling bin should call the Department of Public Works Hotline at 856-757-7034 or visit the City webpage at www.ci.camden.nj.us.

Also, as required by a state electronic waste management act, items known collectively as electronic waste or e-waste including old televisions, computers and computer monitors must be recycled. The electronic waste management act bans the disposal of televisions and all personal or portable computers including desktop, notebook and laptop computers, as well as computer monitors in the regular waste stream. Residents will have to take these items to drop off points such as a county e-waste collection event at specific locations on specific days or at a participating electronics retail store.

Camden County has an e-waste recycling program in place. You can also take e-waste to a participating electronic retail stores and community based service programs. It is best to call ahead to make sure that participating store will take the items you have. Residents can call Camden County at 856-858-5241 for information on their e-waste recycling program and days, places and times that e-waste can be dropped off (proof of residency will be required).
