

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Camden City youth age 16-24 who are:

- Out of school
- Lacking a high school diploma or equivalency
- Willing to complete training and obtain a job
- Registered with the Camden County Youth One-Stop

Program Benefits:

All youth will receive a stipend for participation if they meet certain program criteria for attendance and participation. In addition, those who successfully complete all of the program components and pass all required testing will also receive:

- New Jersey endorsed high school diploma
- An Industry recognized credential through one of six occupational areas
- Certificate of work experience
- Mentoring & case management support services

Camden Corps Plus is an innovative initiative that will provide Camden City youth who do not have a high school diploma or access to job training with unique educational and occupational training opportunities.

Over the course of one year, youth will have an opportunity to take classes on a college campus and study for the high school completion test. Participants will receive occupational training in one of six areas including website design, certified nursing assistant, advanced manufacturing, culinary arts, carpentry construction, and Cisco networking.

To support the youth, Camden Corps Plus will offer mentoring and stipends for community service activities, job sampling, and paid internships.
