TRENTON – The state Department of Transportation has awarded \$24.3 million to fund road improvement projects across the tri-county region.

The money includes more than \$9.6 million to upgrade roads in Camden County. Camden City leads the way, receiving almost \$1 million for various projects.

Some of the other biggest awards in the county are earmarked for John Tipton Boulevard in Pennsauken; Hampton Gate and Drexel Gate drives in Winslow; and Echelon and Kirkbride roads in Voorhees.

Grants totaling a little more than \$9 million will go to Burlington County municipalities, including \$349,500 to resurface Garfield Drive in Willingboro.

In Gloucester County, more than \$5.6 million in grants will fund projects for roads including Forest Drive in Monroe and West Centre Street in Woodbury.

"These funds are instrumental in allowing each municipality to maintain its local roads and bridges in a state of good repair," Gov. Phil Murphy said in a news release. "Providing grants to nearly 90 percent of our towns and cities is truly historic and demonstrates our commitment to relieve pressure on local property taxpayers."

More than \$161 million is being awarded to 505 New Jersey communities. Last year, \$78.75 million in grants was distributed to 364 municipalities.
