CITY OF CAMDEN ANNOUNCES HEAT ADVISORY AND AIR QUALITY ALERT

CAMDEN, NJ – Please be advised that the County Health Officer has issued a Heat Advisory for today, 6/12/17 and tomorrow, 6/13/17 from 12 noon until 7:00 PM.

Also, the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection has issued a code orange air quality alert for Monday, June 12, 2017 for Camden County. A code orange air quality alert means that air pollution concentrations within the region may become unhealthy for sensitive groups. Sensitive groups include children, people suffering from asthma, heart disease or other lung diseases, and the elderly. The effects of air pollution can be minimized by avoiding strenuous activity or exercise outdoors. For updates or additional information relating to air quality please visit www.airnow.gov

The City of Camden is concerned for all persons during extreme weather conditions. It is recommended that individuals limit their outdoor activity during this “Heat Advisory” as determined by the Camden County Health Officer.
