PUBLIC NOTICE
DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT

The City of Camden Department of Planning and Development announces a substantial amendment to the FY 2019 Consolidated Plan to include Care Act funds awarded to the City by the US Department of Housing and Development to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and mitigate economic impacts caused by COVID-19.

The City has received the following allocations for funding which will be utilized as described in the chart below:

1. CDBG: \$1,493,489.00
2. ESG: \$723,110.00
3. HOPWA: \$160,912.00

Public Review and Citizen Comment

Given the need to expedite actions to respond to COVID-19, HUD has waived 24 CFR 91.105(c) (2) and (k) in order to balance the need to respond quickly to the growing spread and effects of COVID-19 with statutory requirement to provide reasonable notice and opportunity for citizens to comment on substantial amendments concerning proposed uses of CDGB, HOME, HOPWA and ESG Funds. As a result, the 30 day minimum for the required public comment period is waived for substantial amendments, provided that no less than 5 days are provided for public comments on each substantial amendment. Subsequently, the City is providing a 5 day public comment period to this proposed substantial amendment to the FY 2019 Consolidated Plan.

The Department of Planning and Development will accept written comment concerning these changes. Comments must be received by June 24, 2020.
