



COMMUNITY CLEAN UP APPLICATION

The Community Clean up is a special and unique opportunity for the Department of Public Works to assist the citizens of the City of Camden to take control of their neighborhood.

HERE WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW TO SCHEDULE YOUR COMMUNITY CLEAN UP:

1. All requests for Community Clean Ups must be scheduled two (2) weeks prior to the desired date.
2. Community Clean ups can be scheduled during the weekdays and Saturdays.
3. No organization or individual should have more than four (4) clean ups per season.
4. Any need for heavy equipment or lot cutting must be requested at the time of application.
5. No clean ups are to be scheduled between **November 15th through April 15th**.
6. You are permitted to clean your surrounding neighborhood. You are not permitted to use a Clean up to clean your personal yards, attics, garages and/or basements.
7. All items generated from the Clean Ups must be bagged and bundled or otherwise containerized debris to be picked up. Bags cannot weigh more than 50 pounds. Do not place out any items that cannot be containerized. For example, metal piping, metal drums, tires, propane tanks, large tree parts, unbundled tree branches and shrubbery etc.
8. You must provide *specific* locations to where the trash will be placed for pick up.



TOOLS AND SUPPLIES

The maximum of tools and supplies per event that can be given are as follows:

- 4 Brooms
- 4 Soft/Hard Rakes
- 4 Shovels
- 15 Biodegradable Trash Bags

(QUANTITIES ARE SUBJECT TO AVAILABILITY)

You are required to pick your tools on the day before your scheduled event. You are required to sign in receipt of said materials. You are required to return the tools back to Public Work. No exceptions.

The individual will be responsible for the return of all items requested and the condition that there are returned. Even if the tools are broken please return all items.

Anyone not returning tools and supplies will no longer be granted the privilege of the Community Clean Up service.

REMOVAL OF TRASH & DEBRIS

The Department of Public Works in conjunction with Waste Management will assist in the removal of all trash and debris collected.

The following are the guidelines for trash disposal:

For Saturday Clean Ups

All trash that you wish to be hauled away will be picked up on Monday morning.

For Weekday Clean Ups

All trash will be hauled away at the end of the Clean up.
