

City of Camden - Tax Office Hours of Operation & Payments May 1 to June 22, 2020

New Jersey Governor Phil Murphy has declared a public health emergency stemming from the novel coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic. Consistent with Governor Phil Murphy's order, the City of Camden has been observing the practice of social distancing. This is necessary in order to limit the spread of COVID-19 and protect the health of the public.

The City of Camden Tax Office will be open for in-person tax payments from May 1st to May 11th, 2020 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The office will resume full operation during the period of May 12th to June 22nd, 2020 (Tax Sale Date) from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

We ask that only the taxpayer make the in-person payments. No more than four individuals in total will be permitted into the tax office at one time. Each person who enters the City Hall building will be required to wear a facemask, must sign-in with building security, and will be subject to a preventative forehead temperature scan upon entry. This practice is consistent with all personnel who enter the City Hall building.
