MS. MILLER: Good evening. Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided in accordance with the Open Public Meeting Act. The Camden City Planning Board adopted a Resolution approving the schedule of regular meetings to be held during the year of 2023 by, one, posting a copy thereof on the bulletin boards reserved for such purpose in the Office of City Clerk, City Hall, first floor, Camden, New Jersey; two, transmitting a copy thereof to the Courier Post and to the Philadelphia Inquirer. VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: I've been informed that Dr. Williams will not be giving us a Director's Report so we'll just move on from here.

New Business: Certificate of
Appropriateness, Alex Ramos, 2857 Yorkship Square.
The applicant is proposing the installation of a roof in the Fairview Historic District.

Are there any interested parties with us this evening on this matter?

MR. NGUYEN: I'm on 1172. I'm also doing a roof but it's 1172 Collings Road.

MR. EINGORN: You're next on the agenda, sir.

MR. NGUYEN: Okay.
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: So what about the item that we're on now, anybody here with respect to this item?

DR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Chair, could we move to the next one?

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Okay.
Certificate of Appropriateness, Yen
Nguyen, 1172 Collings Road. The applicant is proposing the installation of a roof in the Fairview

Historic District. Is anyone here regarding this matter?

MR. NGUYEN: Yes.
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Did somebody say, yes? Who is the person?

MR. NGUYEN: I'm here.

ALLAN NGUYEN, having first been duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

MR. EINGORN: Will you state your name and address for the record?

MR. NGUYEN: Allan Nguyen on behalf of my mother, Yen Nguyen at 1172 Collings Road, Camden, New Jersey 08104.

DR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Chair, the Certificate of Appropriateness was approved by the HPC at its January meeting. And as the secretary member of the Commission, I have no issues with the approval of the Board tonight of this matter.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Okay. Thank you,

Dr. Williams. So, therefore, I assume you can move forward with a motion.

DR. WILLIAMS: Open to the public, sir.
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: That's right.
Is there anyone from the public that would like to comment on this application? We need to open the floor to the public.

DR. WILLIAMS: Yes.
MR. THOMAS: I move to open to the public.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: I second it. Roll call, please.

MS. MILLER: Mr. Lee.
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Yes.
MS. MILLER: Ian Leonard.
MR. LEONARD: Yes.
MS. MILLER: Councilwoman Reyes-Morton. COUNCILWOMAN REYES-MORTON: Yes.

MR. THOMAS: Yes.

MS. MILLER: Motion carried to approve. Thank you.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Was that to approve
or to open the floor to the public?
DR. WILLIAMS: If I may, let's get some order here. Through the Vice-Chair and I have counsel on call, let's not open to the public by a vote. Just ask through the Chair, if there's anyone from the public that wish to be heard on this matter so we could move forward.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: That's right. Did initially. I'll do it again. Is there anyone in the public or from the public that would like to be heard on this matter?

DR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Vice-Chair, there's no one on the call that wishes to be heard.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: So at this time, the motion that we just approved, I assume that was not for the public?

DR. WILLIAMS: That was for the public. What I'm asking the secretary to do through the Vice-Chair, is to redo the roll call authorizing the approval if that's the Board's wish.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Okay.
MS. MILLER: Going back to reading off the first and second in the roll call again?

DR. WILLIAMS: You're going through the roll call because that was for public, opening for
the public. What you want to do is, you want to reconvene the roll call for the record based on the motions and then redo the roll call authorizing the approval if that's the Board's wish.

MS. MILLER: Okay. Can I have a motion? VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: So moved. MR. HUMPHREY: Second. MS. MILLER: Roll call. Mr. Lee. VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Yes. MS. MILLER: Mr. Leonard. MR. LEONARD: Yes. MS. MILLER: Councilwoman Reyes-Morton. COUNCILWOMAN REYES-MORTON: Yes. MS. MILLER: Mr. Thomas. MR. THOMAS: Yes. MS. MILLER: Mr. Humphrey. MR. HUMPHREY: Yes. MS. MILLER: Motion carried to approve. Thank you. Sorry for the confusion. VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Okay. Moving on to the next item. Amended Final Site Plan, Virtua Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital, Inc. --

MS. MILLER: Mr. Lee, you missed one which is 'C,' Certificate of Appropriateness. VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Certificate of

Appropriateness, Hong Zhang, 317 N. 2nd Street. The applicant is proposing exterior work in the Fairview Historic District.

Is there anyone here with respect to this matter regarding this matter?

DR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Vice-Chair, if I may as well as the Board, as we've done in the past meetings with the $C$ of $A$ which is pretty much administrative, I will recommend that the Planning Board approve this $C$ of $A$ so that the owner can move forward with the emergency work for this property. I did talk to the owner about this and I'm very comfortable with the proposed work for this property. And would recommend to the Planning Board to approve the same.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Okay. Fine. Thank you. Is there a motion?

DR. WILLIAMS: Open to the public. Anybody from the public that wishes to be heard, Mr. Vice-Chair.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: At this time, we would like to open the floor to the public. Is there a motion to do that?

DR. WILLIAMS: No motion required. Anybody in the public that wishes to be heard.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Anybody from the public wish to be heard on this matter? DR. WILLIAMS: Again, there's no hands up for this matter.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: At this time, we'll go to the motion.

MR. HUMPHREY: I make a motion.
DR. WILLIAMS: Motion by Mr. Humphrey.
MS. MILLER: Can I get a second?
MR. THOMAS: Second.
MS. MILLER: Roll call. Mr. Lee.
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Yes.
MS. MILLER: Mr. Leonard.
MR. LEONARD: Yes.
MS. MILLER: Councilwoman Reyes-Morton.
COUNCILWOMAN REYES-MORTON: Yes.

MS. MILLER: Motion carried to approve.
Thank you.
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Amended Final Site Plan, Virtua Our Lady of Lourdes Hospital, Inc., 1600 Haddon Avenue, Block 1301, Lot(s) 1 \& 2. The
applicant is proposing to remove two ADA parking spaces and install a cardboard recycling compactor and a trash compactor.

MS. MILLER: Mr. Vice-Chair, Amended Final Site Plan for Virtua Our Lady Lourdes Hospital will not be heard this evening. It will be coming in March. They have to renotice.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Same thing for the Capital Courtesy Review, right, same thing?

MS. MILLER: Also. Capital Courtesy Review for New Jersey Economic Development Authority for Cooper's Poynt Waterfront Park \& Roads Project Delaware Avenue \& State Street will be heard in March. That meeting is March 9th.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: The next item is, Extension of Time - Minor Subdivision --

DR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Vice-Chair, we'll take them one at a time. For Item $D$ on the agenda, we want the Board to continue the matter to the next meeting by a show of a vote and a motion. Okay?

MS. MILLER: Doctor, we don't need that one to be continued because they didn't notice properly.

DR. WILLIAMS: Okay. Number E, the same?
MS. MILLER: They didn't get a chance to
notice, I don't believe, but I think we should do 'E' anyway just in case.

DR. WILLIAMS: Okay.
MS. MILLER: A motion is in order for Item E.

MR. EINGORN: I would suggest that the motion be to the extent that the applicant properly noticed, the Board would then grant an extension from that basis to the following month.

DR. WILLIAMS: What is the call,
Counselor?
MR. EINGORN: Since there's some confusion as to whether or not there's proper notice, I would just say that the motion should state, that to the extent that there is proper notice, the motion will be carried. If there's not, then the applicant obviously would have to complete notice as required by state law.

DR. WILLIAMS: Which item is that, sir?
MR. EINGORN: That's 'E.'
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Okay. Is there a motion pertaining to the Extension of Time - Minor Subdivision that counsel just articulated?

MS. MILLER: For Item E, we need a motion, please.

MR. LEONARD: So moved.
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Second.
MS. MILLER: Roll call. Mr. Lee.
VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Yes.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Item $F$, Extension of Time - Minor Subdivision, CCIA Athletic Fields: The request for the Planning Board to grant a six-month extension of time to record Subdivision so that all signatures can be obtained and the Deed is recorded within the time required by MLUL.

MR. SHEEHAN: Good evening
Mr. Vice-Chair, my name is Kevin Sheehan. I'm an attorney with Parker McKay. We're the attorneys for the applicant, Camden County Improvement Authority and we had made this request. This Board had granted
minor subdivision approval for the property that was formerly the Campbells Field and is currently the new Rutgers athletic fields at Delaware Avenue and Front Street along the Waterfront. This minor subdivision was approved on August 11th. The Resolution was adopted. The MLUL requires minor subdivision to be recorded within 190 days. That time expires on February 17 th which is a week from Monday.

The deeds have been -- the plans have been revised to address Ms. Johnson's concerns. There have been some back and forth between Dena and the surveyor. The plans had been revised; the deed has been prepared and submitted and approved by Dena. It has been sent to Dr. Williams' office for signature by the Board Secretary and the Board Chair. I believe we should be getting that back signed shortly. I then need to get the signature of the property owner and then get it recorded at the county Clerk's office.

I'm asking for the extension of time because by the time I get it back and get it signed and get it over to the County, I don't want to be beyond the 190 days and then have to come back later to the Board. So I'm asking the Board to grant the extension to provide time to complete the signatures
from the City Planning Board so that we can get this recorded.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Okay. Do we need to open this up to the public?

DR. WILLIAMS: It wouldn't hurt to ask anyone if anyone from the public has any comments.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Does anyone from the public have any comments with respect to this request?

DR. WILLIAMS: There's no one on the call that I see with a hand raised. We can move forward. COUNCILWOMAN REYES-MORTON: I have question. Can I get a copy of the application? DR. WILLIAMS: I can forward you over a copy of the request, Ma'am.

COUNCILWOMAN REYES-MORTON: Thank you. VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: At this time, we want to entertain a motion for the extension.

COUNCILWOMAN REYES-MORTON: Motion to an extension.

MR. THOMAS: Second. DR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Thomas seconded it. MS. MILLER: Roll call. Mr. Lee. VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Yes. MS. MILLER: Mr. Leonard.
