Property Tax Exemption Claim by a Disabled Veteran, or a Surviving Spouse/Surviving Civil Union Partner/Surviving Domestic Partner of a Disabled Veteran

If you meet the eligibility requirements listed on the back page of the application, please complete the application and include the necessary documents indicated below.

DISABLED VETERAN EXEMPTION

Please provide a **copy** of one (1) of the following as proof of qualification for this exemption:

- 1. United States Military Discharge Papers indicating dates of active duty service and an **Honorable Discharge**.
- 2. Discharge Form **DD214** indicating dates of active duty service <u>and</u> an Honorable Discharge.

You must also provide us with a Veteran Administration Letter certifying that the veteran is or was 100% totally and permanently disabled from a service-connected disability. This letter is issued through the Department of Veterans Affairs Regional Office. If you need assistance in obtaining the required Military Discharge papers, please contact the Camden County Veteran Affairs Office at (856) 374-5801.

SURVIVING SPOUSE/SURVIVING CIVIL UNION PARTNER/SURVIVING DOMESTIC PARTNER OF A DISABLED VETERAN

Please provide a <u>copy</u> of the Veteran's **Death Certificate**, and if necessary, a copy of the civil union/domestic partnership registration certificate. If your spouse/civil union partner/domestic partner is not currently receiving the exemption, please provide the documents listed above.

Please note that eligibility requirements stipulate that the Veteran must have been a **New Jersey resident at the time of death** and the surviving spouse cannot have remarried or the civil union partner/domestic partner has not formed a new registered partnership.
