McCray, 2809 Tuckahoe Road. The applicant is proposing the installation of windows in the Fairview Section Historic District. Is there someone here with respect to this application?

MR. BURNS: Mr. Vice-Chair, I don't believe anybody is here on this application but the applicant did appear before the Historic Preservation Commission and agreed to comply with the memorandum of October 4th as it relates to what she's proposing for the windows. BURNS: Ms. Vice-Chair, this applicant did appear before the Historic Preservation Commission on September $28 t h$ and agreed to the conditions that were imposed upon the application by the Historic Commission as it relates to the installation of a screen door in the Fairview Historic District. VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Request for a One-Year Extension of Preliminary \& Final Site Plan Approval; Request for and Project Name Change 1400 Collings Road, Block 728; Lot 2.

MR. BURNS: Mr. Vice-Chair, I received a letter from the applicant's attorney, Capehart \& Scatchard requesting a one-year extension of their approved application. This was formerly under the name of Real Portfolio 5, LLC. It was assigned to -that approval was assigned to St. Joseph's Carpenter Society. They have requested in keeping with the statute, proper statute, a one-year extension of that approval.

And the Board is in a position to grant that approval tonight and $I$ know it has been reviewed through Dr. Willliams' office. And we took no issue with the requested approval -- extension.

Mr. Vice-Chair, this has been on our agenda for an extended period of time. So I think tonight a motion would be appropriate just to simply dismiss this application without prejudice. That allows the Salvation Army to come back and refile. It will not hurt them in their progress, but we don't want them to get an automatic approval either for
signs that we may want to comment on. So that would be my recommendation, a motion to dismiss without prejudice.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Item "'E", Review and Approval authorizing a Resolution referring a proposed Amendment to Chapter 870 of the City of Camden Code, including environmental Justice
provisions to the City of Camden Planning Board for a report as provided for N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26.

Mr. Burns, could you --
MR. BURNS: I don't know if Dr. Williams
is going to be present to provide any information on this. Angela, will Dr. Williams be presenting anything on this?

MS. MILLER: No.
MR. BURNS: We have before us a
Resolution referring a proposed Amendment
to the Chapter 870 of the City of Camden Code, including Environmental Justice provisions to the City of Camden Planning Board for our review and a finding that such provisions are consistent with the City Master Plan.

Governor Murphy recently announced the first Environmental Justice regulations in the entire United States. The purpose of the Environmental Justice Regulations is to reduce pollution in New Jersey's vulnerable communities, including the City of Camden. The City Council wishes to incorporate and expound on the New Jersey Environmental Justice Law which is identified as N.J.S.A.13:1D-157, et sec. And the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection Regulations identified as N.J.A.C.7:1C,
et sec.
Environmental Justice, its requirements and definitions by amending the Chapter 870 so that we incorporate those revisions and changes into the City of Camden's Ordinances.

I know Council met on this. They are the ones that are proposing this Ordinance. I don't know if the Councilwoman wants to add anything to this, but they are certainly worthwhile provisions. And it will have a positive impact based on what we've reviewed or what the City has reviewed on the City of Camden. That's why we're here. I don't if the Councilwoman wants to add anything to that.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Councilwoman?
MS. MILLER: Excuse me, Jim.
MR. BURNS: Yes.
MS. MILLER: Doctor Williams did review it and he does concur with that, the agreement of the review.

MR. BURNS: Very good. That's good to hear.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: Great. So we should do a motion to --

MR. BURNS: The motion, Mr. Vice-Chair, would be to authorize the adoption of this Ordinance
by City Council with a finding that the Ordinance is consistent with the City of Camden Master Plan. So that would be the motion.

VICE-CHAIRMAN LEE: So that specific wording has to be incorporated into the motion or?

MR. BURNS: You can just say, I make that motion. Mr. Vice-Chair, you're free to make that motion as I've read it. Councilwoman has a question on the motion.

COUNCILWOMAN RAMOS: I just have a question. I'm not sure if that's something that $I$ recuse myself from since I've already approved. I don't know if that's a double-dipping-type of thing.

MR. BURNS: No. You are our
representative as a member of the Planning Board so you are certainly free to vote on this Resolution and offer your support since $I$ know you've already offered it in your role as councilwoman. So that would be the motion. We have a motion made by the Chair. Do I have a second?
